Re: White Pines water mains replacement proposal

Below are questions that we believe need to be answered before the village board votes on awarding the engineering contract for the full replacement of the White Pines water system:

## **System Replacement:**

What documentary proof do you have that the water system needs replacing?

Why didn't you share such documentary proof with the residents?

Did any expert base his/her opinion on the flow test results?

If so, why didn't you share the opinion with the White Pine residents?

If an expert did not base his/her opinion on the flow test results then can you postpone the board vote on awarding any contracts related to the replacement of the White Pines water system until the county hires such expert? Please note: the county informed the residents that they did not perform an analysis of the system. See DuPage County letter "Option Two".

Can you postpone the board vote on awarding any contracts related to the replacement of the White Pines water system until the residents review the alleged proof that the system needs replacing?

## **Water main rehabilitation:**

Did any expert (i.e. Engineer) examine other options besides replacement?

If so, why didn't you provide these expert opinion(s) to the residents?

If not, would you allow other experts to examine other options besides replacement and base their opinion on current flow test results?

Can you postpone the board vote on awarding any contracts related to the replacement of the White Pines water system until the county hires an expert to perform such analysis?

Do you agree that other options such as rehabilitation should be explored if it reduces the cost of the project?

In a recent letter distributed to the White Pines residents, why do you only mention options "One" and "Three" that is contained with the County's recent letter?

Why did you not mention (and skip over) option 2 within the county's letter?
